A perfect partnership to deliver taxpayer value







For more than two decades, Fraikin has worked with Harrow Council (London Borough of Harrow) to supply and maintain its vehicle requirements. After an initial start, Harrow's confidence in Fraikin grew and from 2002 Fraikin has supplied 100% of the diverse Harrow Municipal fleet, which currently totals more than 200 specialist vehicles and plant equipment, ranging from vans, minibuses and refuse collection vehicles, to bespoke-built plant trailers, excavators, tractors, sweepers, mowers and quad bikes.

Fraikin also operates a dedicated workshop on-site, which allows for rapid repair and turnaround, as well as unparalleled communication. Talib Sheikh, Regional Engineering Manager, Fraikin, says: "We're within walking distance of our customer and we work extended hours – our operations are based around Harrow Council's needs. We listen to our customers and employ a 'can-do' attitude to ensure the Council gets the most from its fleet and its relationship with Fraikin."

The end result is a fleet that delivers exceptional performance at the lowest cost, giving Harrow Council the greatest return on its investment at a time when councils across the country are under significant pressure to deliver real value for money for taxpayers. The fleet offers 100% vehicle availability for the next working day. In the unlikely event of a breakdown, all vehicles are attended within 60 minutes, with an average response time of just 20 minutes.

- Reprofiled the fleet, allowing the deployment of larger more versatile vehicles which reduce the overall fleet size
- Further optimised contract hire life cycles delivering significant financial savings year on year
- Delivery and management of the driver CPC training, which improves overall efficiency, compliance and cuts maintenance costs
- Billing annually in advance, to offer a financial discount to Harrow
- Solid-tyre policy on heavy plant, and inclusion of puncture-proof gel in vehicles with pneumatic tyres
- Customisation of vehicles to include reinforcement on areas that are prone to greater damage potential than normal

Crunching the numbers

Harrow Council makes extensive use of the FRAIKinVIEW online portal, which provides instant updates and information on the state of the fleet via any device with an internet connection. David Hayes says: "Thanks to FRAIKinVIEW, we get detailed information on our fleet operations which allows us to optimise our mileage and further reduce our fuel spend. It's a very powerful tool and it's indispensable for keeping tabs on our operations."

Plans are also afoot to diversify Fraikin's on-site workshop into a revenue stream for the council, as a DVSA vehicle testing facility (VTF) for third-party commercial vehicles.

David Hayes says: "The reason why we've worked with Fraikin for so many years is because every initiative it develops delivers us a financial saving. Thanks to the company's expertise, we can enjoy a turnkey service that keeps our operating and capital costs and overheads low, delivering great value for the taxpayer. Sustainable steps


Fraikin and Harrow Council are working together on a number of initiatives to cut costs and reduce operational environmental impact.

- Plans to retrofit certain vehicles to run on dual fuel with compressed natural gas (CNG) – expected to reduce CO₂ emissions by 14-18% and significantly reduce fuel running costs
- Construction of CNG storage facilities which could also make use of compressed biomethane (CBM)
- · Driver training to improve fuel efficiency
- Proposals to develop existing workshop into DVSA VTF for commercial vehicles, maximising utilisation of facilities and generating a revenue stream for Harrow Council
